Approved minutes from prior meeting

Special education

- Kara Studwell, assistant principal of Academic resource and student support (ARC) presenting. She also supervises counseling program.

Slide showing that Relative to 10 and Yr. 1 and 2, the 9th grade class has larger numbers of students with IEP's

Reviewed comprehensive education plan goals

- 1. Hire new CLAW director
- 2. Monitor referrals for additional help to ensure appropriate referrals
- 3. Hiring additional special education and ENL staffing

Points made:

- Currently BHSEC has 5 ESL students.
- BHSEC uses the same videos and testing for ENL and Special Education students
- Transition planning for student with disabilities to provide greater access and opportunities
- ARC is trying to accomplish
 - Use MAP Growth
 - Training in phonics
 - Faculty professional development
 - College program orientation for SWD
 - o CLAW
 - CTO and transition resources
 - Revise last year's SWD resource packet
 - Extracurricular, trying to find mentorship and other opportunities, like the summer youth employment

In order to accommodate students with IEPs, especially large influx of these students relative to historical levels, Studwell expects modification of process and product, not content. Further discussion was delayed due to time on why Studwell believes there will be no change in content (depth and breadth of learning) for students relative to classes without students with IEPs

- Studwell also wants to normalize different learning processes. There was not time to discuss how that would be different than current practice
- Short discussion on whether BHSEC will be able to produce quantitative metrics to monitor the impact of the proposed changes in process and product on the learning of students at all levels, including how to address counterfactuals
